**THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS REGULATIONS 1956,
AMENDMENT NO. 4**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 26th day of April 1971

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. J. R. MARSHALL PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Municipal Corporations Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Municipal Corporations Regulations 1956* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Form of claim for enrolment—Form 2 in the First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph 2, and substituting the following paragraph:

“2. I have attained the age of 20 years.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the form of claim for enrolment in the principal regulations, in consequence of the provisions of section 2 of the Local Elections and Polls Amendment Act 1970 reducing from 21 years to 20 years the minimum age for electors.
