**THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS REGULATIONS 1956,

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 13th day of September 1971

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Municipal Corporations Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title**—These regulations may be cited as the Municipal Corporations Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Municipal Corporations Regulations 1956\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

**2. Fee for copy of roll**—Regulation 17 of the principal regulations (as amended by section 7 of the Decimal Currency Act 1964) is hereby further amended by omitting from subclause (2) the words “not exceeding 50c”, and substituting the words “not exceeding \$1”.

These regulations increase from 50c to \$1 the maximum fee that may be charged by a Council for a copy of the district electors roll and all its supplements.
