- 1. This Order may be cited as the Marketing Department (Extension of Powers) Order 1939, Amendment No. 2.
- 2. This Order shall be read together with and form part of the Marketing Department (Extension of Powers) Order 1939* (hereinafter called the principal Order).
- 3. The Schedule to the principal Order is amended by inserting, next after the word "tallow" as inserted by Amendment No. 1 to the principal Order, the following items:—
 - "Linen flax (linum species) and any products thereof.
 - "Copra and copra products."
