- 1. This Order may be cited as the Marketing Department (Extension of Powers) Order 1939, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Marketing Department (Extension of Powers) Order 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).
- 2. The Schedule to the principal Order, as substituted by the Marketing Department (Extension of Powers) Order 1939, Amendment No. 4, is hereby amended by adding the following words:—
 - "Tin, steel, tin sheeting, and steel sheeting.
 - "Galvanized iron.
 - "Wire, wire ropes, and wire netting.
 - "Industrial and farming machinery.
 - "Tanners' supplies.
 - "Sisal and hemp.
 - "Plaster of paris."
