



## THE MOTOR-VEHICLE DEALERS REGULATIONS 1958

COBHAM, Governor-General

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 17th day of December 1958

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Motor-Vehicle Dealers Act 1958, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

#### *Title and Commencement*

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor-Vehicle Dealers Regulations 1958.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1959.

#### *Interpretation*

2. In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires,—

“The Act” means the Motor-Vehicle Dealers Act 1958:

Expressions defined in the Act have the meanings so defined.

#### *Applications for Licences*

3. (1) Application for a motor-vehicle dealer's licence may be made by either a company or an individual, and a licence may be issued to either a company or an individual.

(2) Persons intending to carry on business as motor-vehicle dealers in partnership shall each apply for a licence, and a licence may be issued to each of them.

#### *Testimonials*

4. (1) Except in the case of an application for the renewal of a licence, when any application for a licence is filed, it shall be accompanied by original testimonials from at least three reputable persons as to the character and fitness of every person whose character and fitness are relevant to the issue of the licence.

(2) When any application is filed for consent to any person acting as an officer of a company holding a licence or for consent to employ any person as a responsible employee of the licensee, it shall be accompanied by original testimonials from three reputable persons as to the character and fitness of the proposed officer or employee.

(3) When any application is filed for consent under section 17 of the Act to any person carrying on, or appointing some other person to carry on, the business as a motor-vehicle dealer of any licensee, then, unless the applicant or, as the case may be, the proposed appointee is the Public Trustee or the holder of a licence, it shall be accompanied by original testimonials from three reputable persons as to the character and fitness of the applicant or, as the case may be, the proposed appointee.

(4) Notwithstanding anything in the foregoing provisions of this regulation, the Magistrate, if he thinks fit, may dispense with all or any of the testimonials required by this regulation.

#### *Responsible Employees and Officers of Licensees*

5. (1) On the grant or renewal of a licence, the names of the persons who at the date of the grant or renewal are responsible employees or officers of the licensee and the positions held by them shall appear on the licence.

(2) Where consent is given under section 18 of the Act to the employment of any person as a responsible employee of a licensee or to any person acting as an officer of a licensee that is a private company, the name and capacity of that person and the position held by him shall be endorsed on the licence by the Registrar.

#### *Additional Places of Business*

6. Where under section 12 of the Act notice is given by a licensee of any additional place of business, particulars thereof shall be endorsed on the licence by the Registrar.

#### *Temporary Licences*

7. The Magistrate's consent under section 17 of the Act (which relates to temporary licences) shall be endorsed by him on the licence.

#### *Records to be Kept*

8. The record which by section 21 of the Act every motor-vehicle dealer is required to keep of every transaction in which he has acted as a dealer in relation to the sale, purchase, or exchange of or other dealing in any motor vehicle shall be kept up to date by the licensee in the form of a register, and shall show fully and clearly such of the following particulars as are relevant:

- (a) A description of the motor vehicle involved, including make and engine, chassis, and registered numbers;
- (b) The name and address of the person from whom the vehicle was received, the date when it was received, and the total amount or value of any consideration passing from the dealer to the person from whom it was received;
- (c) The status of the person supplying the vehicle, that is, whether owner or agent or attorney for the owner, hirer, or otherwise;

- (d) Whether or not the vehicle is encumbered and, if so, a description of all known encumbrances;
- (e) Whether the vehicle is purchased by the licensee or received by him as agent on behalf of a principal;
- (f) Where the vehicle is purchased by the licensee and disposed of,—
  - (i) The name and address of the person to whom it is disposed of and the date of disposal; and
  - (ii) The total amount or value of the consideration passing from that person to the dealer; and
- (g) Where the vehicle is disposed of by the dealer as an agent,—
  - (i) The name and address of the person to whom it is disposed of and the date of disposal;
  - (ii) The total amount or value of any consideration passing from the purchaser to the dealer;
  - (iii) The amount in cash received;
  - (iv) The value of any trade-in or other consideration;
  - (v) The amount of any commission charged;
  - (vi) The amount of any sum left on hire-purchase or instalment account;
  - (vii) The amount paid to the principal; and
  - (viii) The value of any vehicle or interest in any vehicle supplied to the principal and particulars of the same.

#### *Forms*

9. (1) The forms set out in the First Schedule to these regulations are hereby prescribed as the forms to be used in respect of the several matters to which those forms relate.

(2) Such variations may be made in any form hereby prescribed as the circumstances of any particular case may require.

#### *Fees*

10. (1) The fees specified in the Second Schedule to these regulations are hereby prescribed as the fees payable in respect of the several matters specified in that Schedule, and shall be paid at the time of the filing of the relevant application.

(2) If the application in respect of which any such fee has been paid is refused, half of the fee so paid shall be refunded to the applicant.

#### *Penalties*

11. Every person commits an offence, and is liable accordingly under section 31 of the Act, to a fine not exceeding £50, who knowingly gives false or misleading information to any person for the purpose of obtaining a motor-vehicle dealer's licence or the renewal of such a licence or the cancellation of such a licence or the consent of a Magistrate or the Registrar of a Magistrate's Court to anything to which these regulations relate.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations prescribe the procedure for applying for motor-vehicle dealers' licences under the Motor-Vehicles Dealers Act 1958 and the testimonials as to character and fitness that must accompany those applications.

The regulations also prescribe the procedure in other matters under that Act, the manner in which dealers are to keep records of transactions, the forms that are to be used for the purpose of applications and other matters arising under the Act, and the scale of fees payable.
