ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 30th day of March 1981

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 26 and 199 of the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor Drivers Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 19, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Drivers Regulations 1964* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1981.

2. Testing fee—The principal regulations are hereby amended by renumbering regulation 9A (as inserted by regulation 2 (1) of the Motor Drivers Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 5) as regulation 9B, and inserting, before that regulation, the following regulation:

“9A. Where an applicant for a licence is required to undergo a practical driving test on the ground that he has not within the previous 12 months been the holder of a licence granted in New Zealand of the class applied for he shall pay a testing fee of \$5.50.”

3. Issue of licences—(1) Regulation 11 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “who is under the age of 70 years”.

(2) Regulation 11 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after subclause (1), the following subclause:

“(1A) Nothing in subclause (1) of this regulation shall apply to any person who—

“(a) Has attained the age of 72 years but has not attained the age of 73 years; or

“(b) Has attained the age of 74 years.”

4. Fee for issue of licence—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 15, the following regulation:

“15A. The fee for the issue of a motor driver’s licence shall be \$2.50 for each year in respect of which it is issued.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 1981, effect the following fee increases:

(a) The testing fee is increased from \$1 to \$5.50:

(b) The annual fee for a driver’s licence is increased from 50 cents to \$2.50.

Previously these fees were set out in section 26 of the Transport Act 1962.

The effect of regulation 3 is to exempt persons aged 70, 71, or 73 who are renewing driving licences from the requirement to sit the tests previously required of all drivers over the age of 70 years.
