Pursuant to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor Drivers Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Drivers Regulations 1964* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
 - 2. Regulation 40 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—
 - (a) By omitting from paragraph (a) of subclause (13) the words "December 1965", and substituting the words "March 1966":
 - (b) By omitting from paragraph (b) of subclause (13) the word "January", and substituting the word "April".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations extend by three months the period in which holders of certain classes of drivers' licences issued under the Motor Drivers Regulations 1940 may continue to drive the kinds of motor vehicles that they were authorised to drive by those licences and may be issued with new licences in conformity with the 1964 regulations.
