Pursuant to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor Drivers Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Drivers Regulations 1964* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
 - 2. Regulation 40 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—
 - (a) By omitting from paragraph (b) of subclause (13) the words "and upon passing the prescribed practical driving test for that kind or those kinds of motor vehicle:":
 - (b) By revoking subclause (14).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations dispense with the requirement of a practical driving test in the case of new classes of driver's licence prescribed by the principal regulations where the applicant is the holder of a licence issued under the Motor Drivers Regulations 1940 entitling him to drive a vehicle comprised in any of those classes and produces a statement that he has had driving experience in such a vehicle.
