PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor Drivers Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Drivers Regulations 1964\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 40 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—
- (a) By omitting from paragraph (b) of subclause (13) the words “and upon passing the prescribed practical driving test for that kind or those kinds of motor vehicle.”;
  - (b) By revoking subclause (14).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations dispense with the requirement of a practical driving test in the case of new classes of driver's licence prescribed by the principal regulations where the applicant is the holder of a licence issued under the Motor Drivers Regulations 1940 entitling him to drive a vehicle comprised in any of those classes and produces a statement that he has had driving experience in such a vehicle.
