ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 24th day of April 1967

THE RIGHT HON. J. R. MARSHALL PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor Drivers Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Drivers Regulations 1964* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the seventh day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Approval of driving instructors—Regulation 34 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (3) the words “a fee of £2”, and substituting the words “a fee of £5”.
