THE MEAT EXPORT CONTROL ORDER 1974

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of May 1974

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 14B (1) of the Meat Export Control Act 1921-22 (as substituted by section 2 (1) of the Meat Export Control Amendment Act 1971), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Meat Export Control Order 1974.

(2) This order shall come into force on the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Meat Board may buy and sell beef—The powers conferred on the Meat Board by section 14B (1) of the Meat Export Control Act 1921-22 (as so substituted) may be exercised in respect of meat derived from cattle.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order empowers the Meat Board to buy, sell, or otherwise dispose of beef produced in New Zealand and exported from or intended to be exported from New Zealand.
