RULES.

1. These rules may be cited as the Marine Engineers' Examination Rules, 1936.

2. These rules shall be read with and form part of the rules relating to the examination of engineers (hereinafter referred to as "the principal rules") made on the 7th day of April, 1936.*

3. The first paragraph of Rule 54 of the principal rules is amended by deleting the word "nine" and substituting the word "six ", and by deleting the words "thirteen and a half " and substituting the word "nine " respectively.

4. The second paragraph of Rule 54 of the principal rules is amended by deleting the word "twelve" and substituting the word "nine", and by deleting the word "eighteen" and substituting the words "thirteen and a half" respectively.
