MARINE ENGINEERS EXAMINATION RULES 1939. AMENDMENT NO. 5

PURSUANT to the Shipping and Seamen Act, 1908, the Minister of Marine hereby makes the following rules.

RULES

1. These rules may be cited as the Marine Engineers Examination Rules 1939, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Marine Engineers Examination Rules 1939,* hereinafter referred to as the principal rules.

2. These rules shall come into force on the date of notification hereof in the Gazette.

3. Rule 4:02 of the principal rules is hereby revoked, and the following rule substituted :-

"4:02. Examinations for certificates as extra first-class engineer will be held at Wellington only and will commence on the Tuesday following the fourth Monday in February, June, and October."

4. Rule 4:08 of the principal rules is hereby amended by adding the following words: "except in the case of the examination for extra first-class certificates the application must reach the said Chief Examiner at least two months prior to the appropriate date of examination specified in Rule $4:0\hat{2}$ ".
