THE MARINE ENGINEERS' EXAMINATION RULES 1939. AMENDMENT NO. 6

PURSUANT to the Shipping and Seamen Act, 1908, the Minister of Marine hereby makes the following rules.

RULES

1. These rules may be cited as the Marine Engineers' Examination Rules 1939, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Marine Engineers' Examination Rules 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the principal rules).

2. These rules shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.

3. Rule 1:08 of the principal rules is hereby amended by omitting the words "Board of Trade", and substituting the words "Ministry of Transport".

4. Rule 2:03 of the principal rules is hereby revoked and the following rule substituted :---

"2:03. The following marine engineers' certificates of service are granted under the authority of section 26 of the said Act :-

(13) As first class engineer, to an officer in His Majesty's Navy who has attained the rank of an engineer.

"(14) As second class engineer, to an officer in His Majesty's Navy who has attained the rank of an assistant engineer.

"The fee for a certificate of service either as first class engineer or second class engineer under this rule shall be £1."

5. Rule 5:05 of the principal rules is hereby amended by adding to the schedule of time allowances appended to the second paragraph the following words :---

"Welding

- Full time up to a maximum of . . three months.
- a substantial nature

..

"Electrical repair work of Full time up to one year. Where more than one year has been spent on such work only half the additional time with a maximum

of six months will count."

6. Rule 5:08 of the principal rules is hereby amended by omitting the words "Board of Trade" wherever they occur, and substituting in each case the words "Ministry of Transport".

8. Rule 17:06 of the principal rules is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "a motor-ship", the words "A candidate taking advantage of this provision will be required to take a subject paper in drawing as part of the examination.".
