Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor-drivers Emergency Regulations 1941.
- 2. While these regulations continue in force clause (1) of Regulation 4 of the Motor-drivers Regulations 1940* shall be construed as if the words "On or after" were substituted for the words "Within three months after" before the words "the expiry of a motor-driver's license".
