THE MOTOR-VEHICLES (LICENSING FEES EXEMPTION) REGULATIONS 1948, AMENDMENT NO. 1

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act, 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor-vehicles (Licensing Fees Exemption) Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor-vehicles (Licensing Fees Exemption) Regulations 1948* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. These regulations shall come into force on the fourteenth day following the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 3. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:—
 - "(n) Any other machinery of a type or kind approved for the purpose of this Schedule by the Minister of Transport by notice in the Gazette."
- 4. The Third Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following clause:—
- "(5) Any armoured vehicle of the self-laying-track type used exclusively as part of the armament of any of His Majesty's Forces."
