PURSUANT to the Marriage Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Marriage Fees Regulations 1952.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1952.

2. There shall be paid to the Registrar-General and to every Registrar for the various matters set out in the Schedule hereto the respective fees set out in the said Schedule.
