



**THE MARINE FARMING (FEES) REGULATIONS 1994**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At Wellington this 29th day of August 1994

PURSUANT to section 48 of the Marine Farming Act 1971, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

---

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Marine Farming (Fees) Regulations 1994.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1994.

**2. Interpretation**—In these regulations, “the Act” means the Marine Farming Act 1971.

**3. Fees**—(1) The fee payable in respect of any application for the variation of the conditions of any lease or licence under section 13 of the Act, other than a variation of the species named in the lease or licence, is \$351.

(2) The fee payable in respect of an application for the variation of the species named on any lease or licence under section 13 of the Act is,—

(a) In the case of an application that is publicly advertised, \$747:

(b) In the case of any other application, \$351.

(3) The fee payable in respect of the registration of a lease or licence under section 15 of the Act is \$72.

(4) The fee payable in respect of the provision, under section 15 of the Act, of a certified copy of any instrument registered on the register is \$27.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations which come into force on 1 October 1994, prescribe new fees payable in respect of the variation of leases and licences, the registration of leases and licences, and the provision of certified copies of registered instruments under the Marine Farming Act 1971.

The provisions of the Act relating to the variation of leases and licences are contained in section 13, which was repealed by section 362 of the Resource Management Act 1991 but continues to apply to existing leases and licences by virtue of section 426 of that Act.

The registration provisions to which these regulations apply are contained in subsections (6) and (8) of section 15 of the Marine Farming Act 1971.
