MARINE FARMING (FEES) REGULATIONS 1997

PURSUANT to section 48 of the Marine Farming Act 1971, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Marine Farming (Fees) Regulations 1997.

(2) These regulations come into force on 1 October 1997.

2. Interpretation—In these regulations, "the Act" means the Marine Farming Act 1971.

3. Fees—(1) The fee payable in respect of any application for the variation or extension of a lease or licence under section 13 of the Act is \$967.50.

(2) The fee payable in respect of every application for a consent under section 12 of the Act to the assignment, subletting, or parting with possession of the whole or any part of a leased or licensed area is \$607.50.

(3) The fee payable in respect of the registration of a lease, licence, mortgage, or other instrument under section 15 of the Act is \$123.75.

(4) The fee payable in respect of the provision under section 15 of the Act of a certified copy of any instrument registered on the register is \$123.75.

4. Fees inclusive of GST—The fees specified in regulation 3 are inclusive of goods and services tax.

5. Revocation—The Marine Farming (Fees) Regulations 1996 (S.R. 1996/273) are revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 1997, revoke and replace the Marine Farming (Fees) Regulations 1996. They prescribe a new scale of fees in respect of the variation or extension of leases and licences, the registration of leases, licences, and other instruments, applications for consents to assignments and other dispositions of leases and licences, and the provision of certified copies of registered instruments under the Marine Farming Act 1971.
