(RECIPROCITY WITH UNITED KINGDOM) NOTICE 1960**

PURSUANT to section 80 (3) of the Social Security Act 1938 (as enacted by section 18 of the Social Security Amendment Act 1960), the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

**NOTICE**

1. This notice may be cited as the Medical, Hospital, and Related Benefits (Reciprocity with United Kingdom) Notice 1960.

2. It is hereby declared that persons ordinarily resident in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, not being the master or officer or any other member of the crew of any ship, shall be entitled while in New Zealand to claim the several benefits provided for in Part III of the Social Security Act 1938.
