THE MAIN HIGHWAYS BOARD (FEES AND TRAVELLING-ALLOWANCE) REGULATIONS 1948

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 28th day of
July, 1948

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Main Highways Act, 1922, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Main Highways Board (Fees and Travelling-allowance) Regulations 1948.
2. For the purposes of these regulations,—
 - “Board” means the Main Highways Board established by the Main Highways Act, 1922 :
 - “Member” means a member of the Board appointed in accordance with the provisions of the Main Highways Act, 1922, and who is not an officer employed in the service of the Crown.

TRAVELLING-EXPENSES

3. There shall be refunded to every member the expenses reasonably incurred and actually paid by him in going to or returning from any meeting of the Board or of any committee thereof of which he is a member, or any such expenses otherwise incurred in connection with the business of the Board.

FEES AND LIVING-ALLOWANCE

4. There shall be paid to every member a fee of £2 2s. for every day or part of a day on which he is engaged in connection with the business of the Board.
5. There shall be paid to every member, in addition to any amounts which may be payable to him under Regulation 3 and Regulation 4 hereof, a living-allowance of £1 7s. 6d. for every day or part of a day on which he is engaged in connection with the business of the Board :

Provided that where a member leaves and returns to his usual place of residence on the same day he shall not be paid any living-allowance for that day, and he shall be paid his fee and his actual and reasonable expenses only.

6. For the purposes of the last two preceding regulations and of the next succeeding regulation a member shall be deemed to be engaged in connection with the business of the Board—

- (a) While he is going to or returning from any meeting of the Board or of any committee thereof of which he is a member, or any other meeting at which he is acting as a representative of the Board; or
- (b) While he is in attendance at any such meeting; or
- (c) While he is otherwise travelling on or engaged in connection with the business of the Board.

CERTIFICATE

7. No claim made by any member for travelling-expenses, fees, or living-allowance under these regulations shall be recognized or paid unless it bears a certificate signed by the claimant in the following form :—

I hereby certify that on each of the days to which this claim relates I was engaged in connection with the business of the Main Highways Board, and that I incurred and actually paid the travelling-expenses claimed.

REPEAL

8. The regulations as to fees and allowances of members of the Main Highways Board made on the 29th day of October, 1923, and published in the *Gazette* on the 1st day of November, 1923, at page 2750, are hereby revoked.
