**THE MAIN HIGHWAYS BOARD (TRAVELLING-ALLOWANCE)
REGULATIONS 1950**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 5th day of
July, 1950

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Main Highways Act, 1922, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Main Highways Board (Travelling-allowance) Regulations 1950.

2. The Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949* shall apply to and be deemed to be incorporated in these regulations so as to relate to the Main Highways Board established under the Main Highways Act, 1922, and its members.

3. The subsistence allowance referred to in regulation 5 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be at the rate of £1 15s. a day :

Provided that where any person who is entitled to a subsistence allowance under these regulations occupies a hotel room for one night only, an additional amount of 2s. may be paid to that person.

4. The rate of the mileage allowance referred to in regulation 13 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be calculated in accordance with the following table :—

Horse-power of Car.	Mileage Allowance.
Not exceeding 9½	5½d. a mile.
Exceeding 9½ but not exceeding 14½	6¼d. a mile.
Over 14½	7d. a mile.

5. Garage expenses payable to a member pursuant to this regulation shall not exceed 2s. 6d. for every night on which any such expenses are incurred.

6. The remuneration by way of fees which shall be paid to each member of the Main Highways Board who is not an officer employed in the service of the Crown shall be £3 3s. for each day or part of a day during which he is travelling or occupied in connection with the business of the Board.

7. The Main Highways Board (Fees and Travelling-allowance) Regulations 1948* are hereby revoked.
