THE MENTAL HEALTH REGULATIONS 1912, AMENDMENT NO. 2

Pursuant to the Mental Health Act 1911, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Mental Health Regulations 1912, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the regulations made under the Mental Health Act 1911 on the 26th day of February 1912* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1958.
- 2. (1) The principal regulations may hereafter be cited as the Mental Health Regulations 1912.
- (2) The additional regulations made under the Mental Health Act 1911 on the 5th day of August 1929† may hereafter be cited as the Mental Health Regulations 1912, Amendment No. 1.
- 3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "For each certificate, £1 1s.", and substituting the words "For each certificate, £2 2s.".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the existing regulations under the Mental Health Act 1911. The existing regulations may hereafter be cited as the Mental Health Regulations 1912.

Regulation 3 of these regulations increases from £1 1s. to £2 2s. the fee payable to a medical practitioner for a medical certificate given in respect of an application for the reception of a patient in a mental hospital.

Regulation 4 revokes spent provisions of the existing regulations.
