**THE MUTUAL INSURANCE REGULATIONS 1956,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 3rd day of December 1958

Present:
HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Mutual Insurance Act 1955, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Mutual Insurance Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Mutual Insurance Regulations 1956* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule, and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

3. The principal regulations are hereby further amended by adding to the Second Schedule the words:

“Theft insurance.
Boiler and pressure vessel explosion insurance.
Machinery breakdown insurance.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations substitute a new First Schedule to the principal regulations so as to recognise changes in the names of two of the associations. They also add to the classes of insurance which an association may grant to its members subject to the conditions specified in the principal regulations.
