**THE MAORI INCORPORATIONS REGULATIONS 1969,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 26th day of April 1976

Present:

THE HON. B. E. TALBOYS PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Maori Affairs Act 1953 and the Maori Affairs Amendment Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Maori Incorporations Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Maori Incorporations Regulations 1969* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Election of members to committee of management—(1) Regulation 16 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following proviso:

“Provided that a member of the committee who, pursuant to section 54 of the Act, is due to retire at the meeting at which the election is to be conducted shall be deemed to have been nominated for the election in accordance with this regulation unless he lodges at the registered office of the incorporation, not less than 21 clear days before the time fixed for the meeting, written notice to the effect that he does not accept nomination for the election.”

(2) Regulation 16 (5) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following proviso:

“Provided that where the secretary has been nominated to fill a vacancy in the committee and an election is required pursuant to this subclause, the chairman shall appoint some person approved by the meeting other than the secretary to carry out the duties of the secretary under this subclause.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the provisions of the Maori Incorporations Regulations 1969 which relate to the election of members of a committee of management. The amendments provide—

- (a) That a retiring member of a committee is automatically nominated for re-election unless he gives notice to the contrary; and
- (b) That, where the secretary is a candidate in an election, a person or persons other than the secretary shall be appointed to count the votes.
