



**THE MARINE INSURANCE (WAR RISKS) EMERGENCY
REGULATIONS 1942, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

THE HON. D. G. SULLIVAN PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Marine Insurance (War Risks) Emergency Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Marine Insurance (War Risks) Emergency Regulations 1942* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) Where any contract for the insurance of any ship under the principal regulations has heretofore been or is hereafter terminated for any reason before the expiration of the insurance period, there may be paid out of the Marine Insurance (War Risks) Fund, by way of a refund of premium, such amount as the General Manager thinks fit, not exceeding an amount bearing to the premium paid in respect of the ship for the full insurance period the same proportion as is borne to the full insurance period by the number of days between the termination of the contract and the end of the insurance period.

(2) All refunds heretofore made of premiums paid under the principal regulations shall be deemed to have been lawfully made.
