HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor-Vehicles Insurance (Third-Party Risks) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 10, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor-Vehicles Insurance (Third-Party Risks) Regulations 1963* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1972.

2. Schedule of premiums—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Motor-Vehicles Insurance (Third-Party Risks) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 9), and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

3. Revocation—The Motor-Vehicles Insurance (Third-Party Risks) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 9, are hereby revoked.
