THE MOTOR-VEHICLES INSURANCE (THIRD-PARTY RISKS) REGULATIONS, AMENDMENT NO. 4.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 8th day of March, 1939.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Motor-vehicles Insurance (Third-party Risks) Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor-vehicles Insurance (Third-party Risks) Regulations, Amendment No. 4.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Motor-vehicles Insurance (Third-party Risks) Regulations 1934* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the fourteenth day after notification in the Gazette of the making hereof.
- 4. (1) Regulation 1 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the definition of "rental car" the words "but does not include a passenger-service vehicle as defined in the Transport Licensing Act, 1931."
- (2) The Second Schedule to the principal regulations (as replaced by Regulation 4 of the Motor-vehicles Insurance (Third-party Risks) Regulations, Amendment No. 3)† is hereby amended by adding to the description of Class 8c after the word "service-coaches" the words "but not being rental cars".
