

# THE MEAT LEVY REGULATIONS 1954

# C. W. M. NORRIE, Governor-General ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 6th day of October 1954

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Meat Export Control Act 1921–22, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Meat Levy Regulations 1954.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1954.
- 2. The charges payable by way of levy on meat exported from New Zealand to which section 13 of the Meat Export Control Act 1921–22 applies shall not exceed  $\frac{3}{3}$ 2d. a lb.
  - 3. The Meat Levy Regulations 1953\* are hereby revoked.

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations prescribe the maximum levy that may be charged on exported meat for the purposes of the Meat Export Control Act 1921-22.
