THE MASTERTON LICENSING TRUST (TRAVELLING-ALLOWANCE) REGULATIONS 1948

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Masterton Licensing Trust Act, 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Masterton Licensing Trust (Travelling-allowance) Regulations 1948.

2. The Travelling-allowance Regulations 1941* (hereinafter referred to as the said regulations) shall apply to and be deemed to be incorporated in these regulations so as to relate to the Masterton Licensing Trust and its members.

3. The subsistence allowance referred to in Regulation 4 of the said regulations shall be after the rate of 27s. 6d. per day.

4. The mileage-allowance referred to in Regulation 11 of the said regulations for journeys performed in a motor-vehicle shall be computed according to the horse-power of the vehicle on R.A.C. rating after the rates following, namely—

(a) Where the horse-power of the vehicle does not exceed 9½, 5½d. per mile;

(b) Where the horse-power of the vehicle exceeds $9\frac{1}{2}$ but does not exceed $14\frac{1}{2}$, $6\frac{1}{4}$ d. per mile;

(c) Where the horse-power of the vehicle exceeds $14\frac{1}{2}$, $6\frac{3}{4}$ d. per mile

5. The amount payable in respect of actual garage expenses referred to in Regulation 11 of the said regulations shall not exceed 2s. 6d. for every night.
