## A PROCLAMATION

Pursuant to subsection (2) of section 1 of the Merchandise Marks Act 1954, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim as follows:

- 1. This Proclamation may be cited as the Merchandise Marks Act Commencement Order 1955.
- 2. The Merchandise Marks Act 1954 shall come into force on the 15th day of July 1955.
