PURSUANT to section 204 (2) of the Maritime Transport Act 1994, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Masters, Mates, and Fishing Deckhands (Coastal, Fishing, and Restricted-Limit Ships) Qualification Regulations 1993, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Masters, Mates, and Fishing Deckhands (Coastal, Fishing, and Restricted-Limit Ships) Qualification Regulations 1993* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Testimonials—Regulation 10 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette, revoke regulation 10 (2) of the Masters, Mates, and Fishing Deckhands (Coastal, Fishing, and Restricted-Limit Ships) Qualification Regulations 1998.

The effect of the amendment is to remove a restriction on suspended persons and certain other persons from sitting examinations for certificates of competency under the principal regulations.
