PURSUANT to section 204 (2) of the Maritime Transport Act 1994, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Masters, Mates, and Fishing Deckhands (Coastal, Fishing, and Restricted-Limit Ships) Qualification Regulations 1993, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Masters, Mates, and Fishing Deckhands (Coastal, Fishing, and Restricted-Limit Ships) Qualification Regulations 1993\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Testimonials**—Regulation 10 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, revoke regulation 10 (2) of the Masters, Mates, and Fishing Deckhands (Coastal, Fishing, and Restricted-Limit Ships) Qualification Regulations 1993.

The effect of the amendment is to remove a restriction on suspended persons and certain other persons from sitting examinations for certificates of competency under the principal regulations.
