THE MURUPARA MILK DISTRICT ORDER 1965

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 1st day of March 1965

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Milk Act 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Murupara Milk District Order 1965.

(2) This order shall come into force on the (2) day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Borough of Murupara and parts of the Counties of Taupo, Rotorua, and Whakatane are hereby constituted and declared a milk district with the name of the Murupara Milk District; and the boundaries of the said district shall be those specified in the Schedule hereto.

3. The Milk Authority for the said district shall be the Murupara Borough Council.

4. The Rotorua County Council and the Whakatane County Council shall each be entitled to have a representative on the Milk Committee of the Murupara Borough Council and from time to time to nominate one person for that purpose.

5. The Murupara Borough Council shall from time to time appoint to the Milk Committee of the Borough Council the persons nominated by the Rotorua County Council and the Whakatane County Council pursuant to clause 4 hereof.

SCHEDULE

THE MURUPARA MILK DISTRICT

ALL that area in the South Auckland Land District, Counties of Rotorua, Whakatane, and Taupo, Borough of Murupara, containing 31,080 acres, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the north-western boundary of Section 24, Block XIII, Galatea Survey District, produced in a south-westerly direction, to the right

bank of the Rangitaiki River; thence generally northerly along the aforesaid right bank to its intersection with the production southerly of the western boundary of Section 50, Block XIII aforesaid; thence generally westerly and northerly along a series of right lines bearing $61^{\circ} 30'$, distance 1300 links, $97^{\circ} 45'$, 600 links, $315^{\circ} 0'$, 1640 links, $30^{\circ} 0'$, 600 links, $15^{\circ} 30'$, 960 links, $28^{\circ} 15'$, 140 links; thence due west 55 chains, due north 30 chains, due west 80 chains, due north 20 chains, due west 450 chains, due north 200 chains, due west 60 chains, due north 100 chains, due east 500 chains, due south 50 chains, and due east to its intersection with the western side of the public road; thence generally north-easterly along the north-western side of that public road to the southernmost corner of Part Lot 1, D.P.S. 848; thence due south along a right line to a point on the north-western boundary of Lot 4, D.P.S. 6675; thence generally north-easterly along the aforesaid north-western boundary, to and along the northern boundary of Lot 3, D.P.S. 6675, to the easternmost corner of that Lot; thence generally easterly along the southern side of a public road to the northernmost corner of Lot 2, D.P.S. 4730; thence by a right line to the northernmost corner of Section 14, Block VI, Galatea Survey District; thence south-easterly and south-westerly along the north-eastern and south-eastern boundaries of the aforesaid Section 14, south-westerly and north-westerly along the south-eastern and north-western boundaries of Section 15, Block VI aforesaid, to the easternmost corner of Section 53, Block VI aforesaid; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of the aforesaid Section 53, to and along the south-eastern boundary of Part Section 42, Block VI aforesaid, and its production to a point in the middle of the Haumea stream; thence generally south-westerly up the middle of that stream, to a point on the south-eastern boundary of Section 11, Block IX, Galatea Survey District; thence south-easterly along that boundary, to and south-westerly along the north-western boundary of Section 25, Block IX aforesaid, to and south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of Section 49s, Galatea Settlement, to and south-easterly along the south-western boundary of Section 14, Block IX aforesaid, to and south-westerly along the north-western boundary of Section 6, Block IX aforesaid, and its production south-westerly to a point on the south-western side of Jolly Road; thence south-easterly along the south-western side aforesaid, to and along the north-eastern boundary of Part Section 5, Block IX aforesaid, to and south-westerly along the north-western boundary of Section 30s, Galatea Settlement, to its westernmost corner; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundaries of Sections 29s, 28s, 27s, all of Galatea Settlement, to and south-easterly along the south-western boundary of Section 44, Block XIII, Galatea Survey District, to and north-easterly along the north-western boundary of Section 47, Block XIII aforesaid; thence generally south-easterly along the south-western boundaries of Sections 23s and 22s, both of Galatea Settlement, to the north-western side of Troutbeck Road; thence generally south-westerly along the aforesaid north-western side, to and along a right line across Whirinaki Road to the easternmost corner of Section 2s of Galatea Settlement; thence generally south-westerly along the south-eastern boundaries of Section 2s aforesaid, Section 67s, and Part Section 1s, both of Galatea

Settlement, to the southernmost corner of Part Section 1s aforesaid; thence by a right line to the southernmost corner of Part Section 1s aforesaid; thence by a right line to the southernmost corner of Part Whirinaki 2 Part Section 1A Block, situated in Block XIII, Galatea Survey District; thence generally westerly along the northern boundaries of Whirinaki 2 Part Section 3B 3B and 2 Section 3B1 Blocks, to a point on the north-eastern boundary of State Highway No. 38; thence by a right line to the easternmost corner of Section 54, Block XIII aforesaid; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundaries of Sections 54 and 55, Block XIII aforesaid, to and north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of Section 56, Block XIII aforesaid, and its production north-westerly to a point on the south-eastern boundary of Section 24, Block XIII aforesaid; thence north-easterly and generally north-westerly along the south-eastern and generally north-eastern boundaries of Section 24 aforesaid; and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the point of commencement.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order provides for the constitution of a milk district at Murupara, and constitutes the Murupara Borough Council as the Milk Authority for the district. The Rotorua County Council and the Whakatane County Council are each to be entitled to have a representative on the Milk Committee of the Murupara Borough Council.
