

THE MEAT (ZUIYO MARU NO. 3) EXEMPTION REGULATIONS 1986

ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 49 (1) (z) and 50 (1) of the Meat Act 1981, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title, commencement, and expiry—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Meat (Zuiyo Maru No. 3) Exemption Regulations 1986.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
 - (3) These regulations shall expire with the 30th day of September 1986.
- 2. Fishing vessel exempted from certain licensing requirements—The vessel known as Zuiyo Maru No. 3 (a Japanese registered vessel to which there is assigned by the competent Japanese authorities the distinctive number 103937) is hereby exempted from all the licensing requirements of the Meat Act 1981.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which expire at the end of the 1985-86 fishing season (30 September 1986), exempt from the licensing requirements of the Meat Act 1981 a fishing boat intended to undertake research into the potential of the resources of New Zealand fisheries waters for the production of surimi. Surimi is washed, minced fish, frozen into blocks.
