



**THE MEAT MARKETING ORDER 1942, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL.**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 7th day of April, 1943.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Marketing Act, 1936, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

**ORDER.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Meat Marketing Order 1942, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Meat Marketing Order 1942\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. Clause 3 of the principal Order is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (1) the words " and before the 1st day of October, 1942."

3. Clause 6 of the principal Order is hereby amended by inserting, after the word " accepted ", the words " or deposited ".

4. (1) The principal Order is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule thereto, and substituting the following Schedule :—
