ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Meat Marketing Order 1942, Amendment No. 9 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Meat Marketing Order 1942* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. (1) The principal order is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule thereto (as replaced by clause 2 of the Meat Marketing Order 1942, Amendment No. 8), and substituting the following Schedule:—

- (2) The Meat Marketing Order 1942, Amendment No. 8, is hereby revoked.
- (3) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the foregoing provisions of this clause, the principal order, as heretofore amended, shall, with respect to meat that has been derived from stock killed before the 1st day of October 1951, be read as if this clause had not been enacted.
- 3. (1) Clause 10 of the principal order is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (a) the word "thirteen", and substituting the word "six".
- (2) This clause shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1952.
