ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 5th day of September 1966

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. J. R. MARSHALL PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Milk Act 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Milk Marketing Order 1962, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Milk Marketing Order 1962* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) In so far as this order fixes the prices payable to milk producers and associations of milk producers, it is made on the recommendation of the Minister of Agriculture.

(3) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1966.

2. (1) The principal order is hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by clause 2 of the Milk Marketing Order 1962, Amendment No. 4), and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule hereto.

(2) Clause 2 of Milk Marketing Order 1962, Amendment No. 4, is hereby revoked.
