ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 9th day of August 1967

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Milk Act 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Milk Marketing Order 1962, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Milk Marketing Order 1962* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 10th day of July 1967.

2. (1) The principal order is hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by clause 2 of the Milk Marketing Order 1962, Amendment No. 5), and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the First Schedule hereto.

(2) The principal order is hereby further amended by revoking the Third Schedule (as amended by the Milk Marketing Order 1962, Amendment No. 1, and the Milk Marketing Order 1962, Amendment No. 4) and substituting the Third Schedule set out in the Second Schedule hereto.

3. The Milk Marketing Order 1962, Amendment No. 1, the Milk Marketing Order 1962, Amendment No. 4, and the Milk Marketing Order 1962, Amendment No. 5, are hereby revoked.
