PURSUANT to the Milk Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

O R D E R

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Milk Marketing Order 1968, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Milk Marketing Order 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1974.

2. Records showing sales of milk—Clause 5 of the principal order is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (c) of subclause (4) the words “2 gallons”, and substituting the words “12 litres”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order amends the Milk Marketing Order 1968. Clause 5 (4) (c) of the principal order requires vendors to keep detailed records showing the daily total sales of milk to each commercial user or consumer in quantities of not less than 2 gallons. The effect of the amendment is to require detailed records to be kept showing the daily total sales of milk to each commercial user or consumer in quantities of not less than 12 litres instead of not less than 2 gallons. (1 gallon is almost equivalent to 4.546 litres.)
