ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 9th day of October 1978

PURSUANT to the Milk Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Milk Order 1978.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Products declared to be milk—The following products of milk or cream are hereby declared to be milk for the purposes of the Milk Act 1967:

- (a) Skim milk:
- (b) Separated milk:
- (c) Milk from which any proportion of fat has been removed:
- (d) Standard milk as defined in the Food and Drug Regulations 1973*.

3. Repeal—The Milk Order 1971† is hereby consequentially repealed.
