ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 2 of the Meat Act 1981, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Meat (Poultry) Order 1987.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Farmed quail, guinea fowl, and partridges declared to be poultry—Farmed quail, farmed guinea fowl, and farmed partridges are hereby declared to be poultry for the purposes of the Meat Act 1981.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order applies the provisions of the Meat Act 1981 relating to poultry to farmed quail, guinea fowl, and partridges.
