ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 2 of the Meat Act 1981, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Meat (Poultry) Order 1987.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Farmed quail, guinea fowl, and partridges declared to be poultry**—Farmed quail, farmed guinea fowl, and farmed partridges are hereby declared to be poultry for the purposes of the Meat Act 1981.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order applies the provisions of the Meat Act 1981 relating to poultry to farmed quail, guinea fowl, and partridges.
