

# THE MISUSE OF DRUGS ORDER 1981

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 4th day of May 1981

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to section 4 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs Order 1981.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. First Schedule to Act amended—The First Schedule to the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975 is hereby amended by inserting in clause 1, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the following names of substances:

"PCE (N-ethyl-1-phenylcyclohexylamine).

- "PCPY (1-(1-phenylcyclohexyl)pyrrolidine).
- "TCP (1-[1-(2-thienyl)cyclohexyl]piperidine)."
- 3. Second Schedule to Act amended—(1) Part II of the Second Schedule to the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975 is hereby amended by inserting in clause 1, in its appropriate alphabetical order, the name of the following substance:

"NORPSEUDOEPHEDRINE (threo-2-amino-1-hydroxy-1-phenyl-

propane)."

(2) Part III of the Second Schedule to the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975 is hereby amended by inserting in clause 1, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the names of the following substances:

"MECLOQUALONE (3-(2-chlorophenyl)-2-methyl-4(3H)-quinazo-

linone).

"SUFENTANIL (N-[4-(methoxymethyl)-1-[2-(2-thienyl)ethyl]-4-piperidyl] propionanilide).

"TILIDINE ((±)-ethyl hexene-1-carboxylate)." trans-2-(dimethylamino)-1-phenyl-3-cyclo-

4. Third Schedule to Act amended—Part 1 of the Third Schedule to the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975 is hereby amended by inserting in clause 1, in its appropriate alphabetical order, the name of the substance "Catha edulis plant".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order is made pursuant to section 4 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975. It effects a number of amendments to certain Schedules to that Act, most of which are in line with changes agreed to by the United Nations Commission on Narcotic Drugs.
