ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 9th day of April 1984

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. SIR ROBERT MULDOON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs Order 1984.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Third Schedule to Act amended—Part IV of the Third Schedule to the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975 is hereby amended by omitting from clause 1 the item relating to Buprenorphine (as inserted by clause 2 of the Misuse of Drugs Order 1983*), and substituting the following item:

“BUPRENORPHINE (17-cyclopropylmethyl-7,8-dihydro-7-(1-hydroxy-1,2, 2-trimethylpropyl) -6-0-methyl-6, 14-ethano-17-normorphine)”.

3. Revocation—The Misuse of Drugs Order 1983* is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This order amends the name of the specified substance to render it consistent with international scientific usage.
