PURSUANT to section 37 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Misuse of Drugs Regulations 1977* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
 - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1985.

- 2. Hospital records—Regulation 44 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "or the Hospitals Act 1957", the words "or the Area Health Boards Act 1983".
- **3. Communications through Medical Officer of Health**—Regulation 51 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "health district", the words "or area health district".
