**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to section 3 (4) of the Ministry of Energy (Abolition) Act 1989, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the Ministry of Energy (Abolition) Act Commencement Order 1990.

**2. Commencement of section 3**—Section 3 of the Ministry of Energy (Abolition) Act 1989 shall come into force on the 31st day of December 1990.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order brings into force on 31 December 1990 section 3 of the Ministry of Energy (Abolition) Act 1989.

Section 3 (1) abolishes the Ministry of Energy.

Section 3 (2) omits the name of the Ministry from the First Schedule to the State Sector Act 1988 (which Schedule lists the Departments of the Public Service).

Section 3 (3) omits the name of the Ministry from the First Schedule to the Ombudsmen Act 1975 (which Schedule lists the Departments and organisations to which that Act applies).
