Pursuant to section 3 (4) of the Ministry of Energy (Abolition) Act 1989, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Ministry of Energy (Abolition) Act Commencement Order 1990.
- 2. Commencement of section 3—Section 3 of the Ministry of Energy (Abolition) Act 1989 shall come into force on the 31st day of December 1990.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings into force on 31 December 1990 section 3 of the Ministry of Energy (Abolition) Act 1989.

Section 3 (1) abolishes the Ministry of Energy.

Section 3 (2) omits the name of the Ministry from the First Schedule to the State Sector Act 1988 (which Schedule lists the Departments of the Public Service).

Section 3 (3) omits the name of the Ministry from the First Schedule to the Ombudsmen Act 1975 (which Schedule lists the Departments and organisations to which that Act applies).
