HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Ministry of Energy (Abolition) Act 1989, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Ministry of Energy (Petroleum Products Specifications) Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Ministry of Energy (Petroleum Products Specifications) Regulations 1988* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Third Schedule amended—The Third Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended—

Ministry of Energy (Petroleum Products Specifications) Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 1

(a) By omitting from note 1 the expression "31 January", and substituting the expression "last day of February":

(b) By omitting from that note the expression "1 February", and substituting the expression "1 March".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations extend the period during which "summer" diesel may be supplied or be available for retail sale.

The current period is 1 September to 31 January.

The new period is 1 September to the last day of February.
