ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 11th day of May 1987

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 44A of the Meat Act 1981, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Meat (Recovery of Inspection Costs) Order 1987.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 15th day of May 1987.

2. Increasing proportion of costs to be recovered—(1) For the purposes of subsection (5) (a) of section 44A of the Meat Act 1981 there is hereby prescribed the proportion of two-thirds.

(2) For the purposes of subsections (5) (f) and 6 (b) of the said section 44A there is hereby prescribed the proportion of 47.5 percent.

3. Revocation—The Meat (Recovery of Inspection Costs) Order 1986 is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases, from 15 May 1987, the amount payable to the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries by the occupiers of premises licensed under the Meat Act 1981 in respect of the indirect costs of the inspection services supplied by the Ministry, which at present is 35 percent of the total amount payable in respect of direct costs, to 47.5 percent of direct costs.
